Job Summary

We are seeking a full-time secondary math teacher who loves Jesus and is flexible to fill additional roles in our small school as needed (potential for PE/Health, and other electives based on experience and interest). Math courses will be for students in 7th-10th grades and include Foundations in Math, Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, and Geometry.

- Maintain accurate records of student progress and communicate that progress efficiently with students and families.
- Adhere to Biblical teachings in class conversations and incorporate into lessons where possible.
- Build positive relationships with students, families, staff, and the community.
- Maintain clear and consistent classroom management to ensure a safe and positive learning environment.
- Participate in school community events throughout the school year, including conferences, programs, and other special events.

Salary Placement

As we are a small, private Christian school, our salary placement begins at \$39,000, with increases each year based on experience and cost of living raises. We have found that although this is not competitive with public school salaries, our teachers are dedicated to the cause of educating students in a Christ-like environment and the salary placement is secondary to the mission we seek to fulfill.
